APPROVAL OF CONTRACT

Alabama Power Company

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the recipient of a \$400,000.00 Omnibus Appropriation through the Alabama Department of Transportation for the relocation of overhead utilities to underground in two blocks of Water Avenue; *and*

WHEREAS, Alabama Power Company has reviewed the proposed scope of work and submitted three options to the City and following careful review along with a professional engineering firm, the City has chosen Proposal "C" in the amount of \$300,000.00, which outlines all specifications and requirements for the scope of work; *and*

WHEREAS, the City shall provide rights-of-way to Alabama Power Company for facilities located on property owned by the City; *and*

WHEREAS, the City will be responsible for trenching, installing conduits, and rewiring services for all secondary circuits, including streetlights and market day receptacles, per Alabama Power specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$300,000.00 with Alabama Power Company, pending ALDOT approval, for relocation of overhead utilities to underground in two blocks of Water Avenue; *and*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED said contract expenses shall be reimbursable from the Alabama Department of Transportation.
