*Program Administration Services as it relates to the
City of Selma Amphitheatre Construction Project*

WHEREAS, the CITY OF SELMA is the recipient of a 2010 Community Development Block Grant Number LR-CE- PF-10-014 from the State of Alabama for the construction of an amphitheater in the City of Selma; *and*

WHEREAS, the City did advertise for Request for Proposals for administrative services in the Selma Times Journal on November 26, 2010 and December 3, 2010; Mobile Register and Montgomery Advertiser on November 30, 2010 from which one response was received and has determined that the Proposal for Administrative Services submitted by Galbraith & Associates, LLC is acceptable; *and*

WHEREAS, the City has complied fully with the procurement requirements as set forth in O.M.B. Circular A-102 Attachment O, and the Common Rule as adopted by the State of Alabama.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that George Evans in his capacity as Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Galbraith and Associates in the amount of \$50,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Galbraith and Associates to perform Administrative Services for the **City of Selma Amphitheatre Construction Project** as set forth in its proposal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the incurred expenses of the agreement are obligated in the 2010 Community Development Block Grant.


