*Authorization to Proceed with the Selma Interpretive Center
Exterior Improvements*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma desires to improve the appearance of the Selma Interpretive Center buildings on Broad Street and Hinton Alley; and

WHEREAS, Frasier-Ousley Construction and Engineering, Inc. submitted a proposal for the labor, materials and equipment to complete the exterior work on the Selma Interpretive Center buildings on Broad Street and Hinton Alley; and

WHEREAS, the proposal for exterior improvements to 4 Broad Street (former Margie's Dance), 6 Broad Street (former Goodwill extension/Rives), 10-12 Broad Street (for Cahaba Furniture) and 14 Broad Street (former Plain Value) totaled \$38,650.00; and


WHEREAS, the proposal to clean, scrape and paint on the Hinton Alley side of building totaled \$9,830.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Patrick Evans in his capacity as Mayor is hereby authorized to enter in agreement with Frasier-Ousley Construction and Engineering, Inc. to proceed with the exterior improvements to 4 Broad Street, 6 Broad Street, 10-12 Broad Street and 14 Broad Street for a proposed amount of \$38,650.00.




